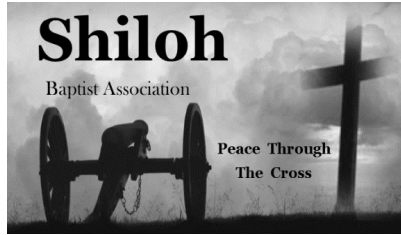
## Poolside Reflections

“Now I plead with you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all speak the same thing, and **that there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment.**” (1 Corinthians 1:10).

The problem at Corinth was carnality that resulted from division (1 Cor. 3:3). Division takes place when loyalties, priorities and fear are misplaced.

- When **loyalty** is stronger for one’s community, school, or even church than it is for the cause of Christ and His Kingdom, then divisions arise. Churches see themselves in competition instead of cooperation.
- When **priorities** are placed more on activities of personal enjoyment than obedience to the Great Commandment and the Great Commission, then there is division of heart for the Gospel. Churches will tend to cater more to the flesh than to the spirit and the result is self-centered preferences taking priority over servant-hearted ministries of Christ reaching out to others.
- When **fear** of man’s opinion is greater than the “fear of the Lord”, then there is a division between Godly convictions and the popular public viewpoint. Churches will become divided over moral issues and allow for carnal behavior – even in the church.

All three of these problems were present at Corinth and as we look around, they are present among us as well. The answer lies in Paul’s words “*that you be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgement.*” The single unifying element of a healthy association of churches is that we “*all speak the same thing*” - the Gospel. We should all have but *one thing on our mind* – seeing lost men, women, boys and girls come to an understanding of the saving grace of and faith in the Lord Jesus Christ. Three verses later Paul asks a question we must ask ourselves, “*Is Christ divided?*” (1 Corinthians 1:13). May our efforts together be the evidence of our answer to that question.
