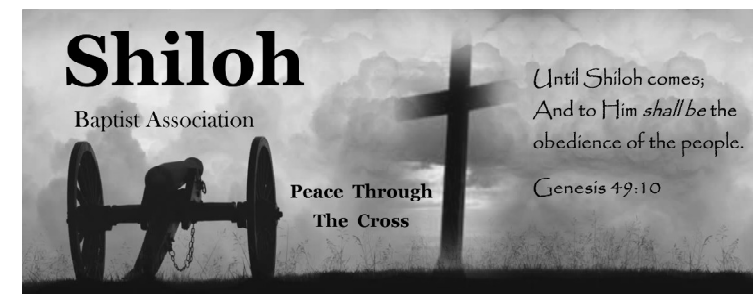

Poolside Reflections –

“Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfil the law of Christ. ... For every man shall bear his own burden.”

Galatians 6:2, 5 - KJV

What appears to be a contradiction in Scripture is anything but. In fact, it is a beautiful picture of cooperation. Allow me to unpack these verses. In verse 2, the term “burden” is “*baré*” and refers to a “heavy weight” that would require assistance. In verse 5, the term “burden” is “*phortion*” and refers simply to “something carried”. The New King James uses the term “load” in verse 5 to distinguish between the two words. Paul is saying that we help others with their heavy burdens while bearing the responsibility of our own load. Picture two men carrying a canoe that neither man could carry by himself, while at the same time, each man carries his own backpack. That is the picture of these two verses.

The application to us is that we must come together to bear the weight of ministry and missions, that the Lord has commanded us all to perform. No one church can evangelize their community, their county, their state, their nation, or the world. It takes all of us working together in cooperation, not competition (or condemnation) to reach all facets of society. Evangelism and missions are the canoe we must carry together if it is to be carried at all. Discipleship is our individual backpack that we must carry ourselves. We must all embrace the responsibility of making disciples of those being won to Christ.

The Cooperative Program unites the concerted effort of our Baptist churches in reaching our Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria and the uttermost. The Shiloh Baptist Association exists to partner with its churches in *their vision* for fulfilling the Great Commission. The “burden” of a lost world requires us to work together. Each one must do their part. It is not either/ or – it is both/ and.
