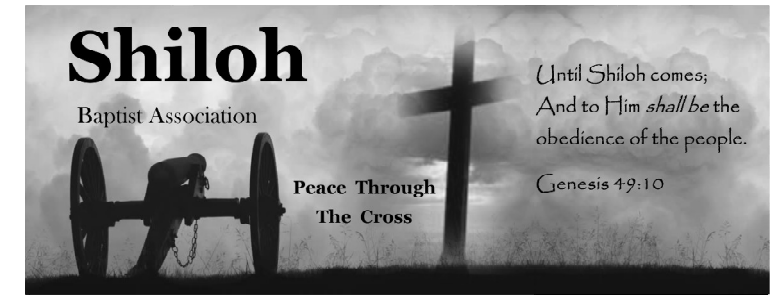

Next month we have an opportunity to give an offering to the Lord that will bring “glory to His name” throughout Tennessee. It is called the *Golden Offering for Tennessee Missions* and is our state mission offering. This offering provides the necessary funding for developing new works, revitalizing established churches, reaching the lost, targeting people groups within the state, meeting human needs and equipping future generations. All of the money given to this offering stays in Tennessee and is used for mission and ministry purposes.

Your offering makes a difference. For example:

- \$3 provides an evangelistic Frisbee (slip disc) to give away at Bonnaroo.
- \$5 provides for the printing of 15 evangelistic tracts for various people groups.
- \$15 buys a backpack filled with school supplies for a child.
- \$25 provides a recorded subscription to the B&R for 1 year to a sight impaired person.
- \$50 provides a box of staple food items for a family living in poverty.
- \$100 provides a scholarship for child or youth to attend All Nations Camp.
- \$300 provides scholarship assistance for a language pastor for seminary extension.
- \$500 provides supplies for building a wheelchair ramp.
- \$1,000 provides a basic block party with a block party trailer for 420 participants.
- \$5,000 provides new communication equipment for Disaster Relief.

Whether you can give a little or a lot, it is the cooperative effort of our TBMB churches that are making a difference across this state. Speaking on behalf of Mississippi River Ministry, I couldn't do what I do without the *Golden Offering for Tennessee Missions*. Make this the year you “give to the LORD the glory due His name” and “bring an offering into His courts!”
